The licensing hearing was conducted for Waldron Friendly Tavern, L.L.C., Request ID# 670473. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Wendy and Bill McCallister appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Hetzel and Ms. McCallister offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated March 1, 2013, and approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer ownership of 2012 Tavern and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Dance-Entertainment Permit from Wendy McCallister, and transfer classification from Tavern to a Class C License. Supported by Commissioner Olshove, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.
