Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:07 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Chairman Deloney, supported by Commission Quimby, to approve the Southfield Appeal Hearing minutes from April 12, 2012, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Kulvir Multani Enterprises, LLC, 791 SE Thirty Second, Wyoming, Kent County Request ID# 609093

The licensing hearing was conducted for Kulvir Multani Enterprises, LLC, Request ID#609093. This matter was tabled from the January 26, 2012 Southfield Appeal Hearing. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, and Attorney Thomas J. Giachino appeared on behalf of the applicant. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to adjourn the hearing until a future date. Commissioner Quimby supported, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. Kathy Investments, LLC, 2960 E. Washington, Saginaw, Buena Vista Township, Saginaw County Request ID#626694

The licensing hearing was conducted for Kathy Investments, LLC, Request ID# 626694. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Thomas J. Giachino and sole member, Kathy Kashat, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Asevedo and Attorney Giachino offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order dated April 4, 2012, and to approve the request to transfer ownership of an escrowed 2011 Specially Designated Distributor and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.) from

Ghazi Mizori Inc., with the stipulation that Mason Kashat have no involvement whatsoever in this license and that the licensee be placed on a cash only basis for one year. Commissioner Quimby supported, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. LMT Party Store, LLC, 213 Pearl, Ypsilanti, Washtenaw County
Request ID# 628140

The licensing hearing was conducted for LMT Party Store, LLC, Request ID#628140. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Attorney Christopher Atallah appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Asevedo and Attorney Atallah offered comments regarding this case. Mr. Asevedo read a written objection from Officer Brooke Harrison of the Ypsilanti Police Department. Officer Harrison could not attend due to a scheduling conflict. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order dated March 14, 2012, and to approve the request for a new Specially Designated Merchant license with permit to sell alcoholic liquor between 7:00 (A.M.) and 12:00 Noon on Sundays. Commissioner Quimby supported, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Chairman Deloney, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:00 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
