Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:15 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Chairman Deloney, to approve the Lansing Appeal minutes from May 8, 2012, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. French Valley Vineyard, L.L.C., 3655 S French Road, Cedar, Centerville Township, Leelanau County Request ID# 630290

The licensing hearing was conducted for French Valley Vineyard, L.L.C., Request ID# 630290. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Attorney Michael J. Corcoran, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Geissler and Mr. Corcoran offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order dated April 4, 2012 and to approve the request to for a new Small Wine Maker license. Supported by Commissioner Quimby, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. Willard G. Leenhouts Post No. 6, The American Legion, 10820 Paw Paw, Holland, Ottawa County Request ID# 632020

Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, David Bradley and Francis Coughlin, appeared on behalf of the licensee.
