Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:07 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Chairman Deloney, that the minutes of the Lansing Appeal hearing of June 12, 2012, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Sidney Tavern, Inc. 3045 S Derby, Sidney, Sidney Township, Montcalm County Request ID# 625434

The licensing hearing was conducted for Sidney Tavern, Inc., Request ID# 625434. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Attorney Scott Millard appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Geissler and Mr. Millard offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial, dated May 9, 2012, and to approve the request to transfer stock in 2012 Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.) and Outdoor Service (1 Area), from stockholder George F. Adams to new stockholder, Timothy E. Lehner. Supported by Commissioner Quimby, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. Madigan's, LLC, 250 W Chicago, Allen, Hillsdale County Request ID# 623637

The licensing hearing was conducted for Madigan's, LLC, Request ID# 623637. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and William Sours appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Geissler and Mr. Sours offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial, dated April 11, 2012 and amended Commission Order of denial, dated May 9, 2012, and to approve the request for a new Dance Permit to be held in conjunction with new Class C license with Outdoor Service (1 Area). Supported by Commissioner Quimby, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.
