Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:08 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Lansing Appeal Hearings of June 4, 2013, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Café Suz, Inc., 6099 Gratiot, Saginaw, Saginaw Township, Saginaw County Request ID#264136

The licensing hearing was conducted for Café Suz, Inc., ID# 264136. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, and Attorney Peter Ramah, appeared on behalf of the licensee. Also present was Gary Glaza, representing the applicant who has applied for a transfer ownership of the licenses. Ms. Hetzel and Mr. Ramah offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated April 17, 2013, and to extend the escrow period of the 2012 Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses to April 30, 2014, as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. Evan T. LaFave, 109 Elm, Munising, Alger County Request ID# 669166

The licensing hearing was conducted for Evan T. LaFave, Request ID# 669166. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Charles Nebel and Evan T. LaFave, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Hetzel, Mr. Nebel and Mr. LaFave offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated May 8, 2013, and to approve the request to transfer

ownership of 2013 Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses from Jolene Elizabeth LaFave, with Evan T. LaFave, Personal Representative, as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. Harby, Inc., 21535 Van Born, Taylor, Wayne County Request ID#673261

The licensing hearing was conducted for Harby, Inc., ID# 673261. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Michael Brown and stockholder Harlan Lee, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Hetzel, Mr. Brown and Mr. Lee offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated April 24, 2013, and to approve the request to transfer ownership of 2013 Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses from The Back Door Bar Inc., as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

5. Constant Change Market LLC, 1041 Griswold, Port Huron, St. Clair County Request ID# 671772

The show cause hearing was conducted for Constant Change Market LLC, Request ID# 671772. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and no one appeared on behalf of the applicant. Also present was Detective Chris Frazier from the Port Huron Police Department. Ms. Hetzel and Det. Frazier offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of approval dated April 11, 2013, and to deny the request for a new Specially Designated Merchant license, as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:18 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
