Commissioner Quimby called the hearings to order at 10:12 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Olshove, that the minutes of the Lansing Appeal hearing of July 10, 2012, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Coyote Creek Grille, L.L.C., 6951 Lansing, Dimondale, Windsor Township, Eaton County Request ID# 424558

The licensing hearing was conducted for Coyote Creek Grille, L.L.C., Request ID# 424558. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Michael Brower, Attorney James Stariha, and member, Lawrence Clark appeared on behalf of the licensee. Mr. Geissler, Mr. Brower and Mr. Clark offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Commissioner Quimby made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated June 13, 2012, and to approve the extension of escrow as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, through April 30, 2013 for the Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (PM), Dance Permit and Outdoor Service (1 Area). Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. M & K Market, LLC, 1107 Howard, Saginaw, Saginaw County Request ID# 615338

The licensing hearing was conducted for M & K Market, LLC, Request ID# 615338, which was tabled from the Lansing Appeal Hearings held on July 10, 2012. Jason

Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Michael Brown and member, Rajpal Singh appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Geissler and Mr. Brown offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Commissioner Quimby made a motion to vacate the previous Commission Order of denial dated May 30, 2012, and to remand the case back to the Licensing Division for further review. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.
