The penalty hearing was conducted for Weston Bar & Grill, Inc., Business ID# 5004. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Dawn Van Dusen and stockholder Mary Lou Kaser appeared on behalf of the licensee. Ms. Hetzel, Ms. Van Dusen and Ms. Kaser offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to suspend the Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses for three (3) consecutive days starting Wednesday, July 9, 2013, and the licensee shall provide proof that within 180 days of this order, a Commission approved server training program has been completed, as set forth in the Penalty Hearing Order. Supported by Commissioner Olshove, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.
