Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:12 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Southfield Appeal Hearing of July 26, 2012, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.

2. Billy G's New Casino Bar, Inc., 4738 E. Davison, Detroit, Wayne County
Request ID# 280778

The licensing hearing was conducted for Billy G's New Casino Bar, Inc., Request ID# 280778. Melinda Leonard appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Attorney Dragan Stojanov, appeared on behalf of the licensee. Ms. Leonard and Mr. Stojanov offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated May 9, 2012, and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, for an extension of escrow until November 30, 2012 for the 2011 Class C license. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. R & J Yaldo, Inc., 640 Auburn, Pontiac, Oakland County Request ID# 629787

The licensing hearing was conducted for R & J Yaldo, Inc., Request ID# 629787. Melinda Leonard appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Ryan Husaynu and Munther Yaldo, president, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Leonard and Mr. Husaynu offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney advised the matter was tabled to a future date.

4. Cruisin1, Inc., 405 S. Dort, Flint, Genesee County Request ID# 634295

The licensing hearing was conducted for Cruisin1, Inc., Request ID# 634295. Melinda Leonard appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Michael Jablonski and Cheyenne Usewick, stockholder, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Leonard and Mr. Jablonski offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated July 18, 2012, and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer ownership of escrowed 2012 Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.), Entertainment Permit (without dressing rooms), Dance Permit, and two (2) Bars from Muggsys' Inc.; request authorization for the sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises between 7:00 A.M. and 12:00 Noon on Sundays; and change existing Entertainment Permit (without dressing rooms) to Entertainment Permit. Commissioner Quimby supported, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

5. Pinckney Petroleum, LLC, 850 Main, Pinckney, Livingston County
Request ID# 533692

The licensing hearing was conducted for Pinckney Petroleum, LLL, Request ID# 533692. Melinda Leonard appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Kelly Allen, and Fawzi R. Simon, president, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Leonard and Ms. Allen offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated June 13, 2012 and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer ownership of 2012 Specially Designated Merchant license with motor vehicle fuel pumps under MCL 436.1541(3) from Barrick Properties #40, L.L.C. Commissioner Quimby supported, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 12:25 p.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
