Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:13 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Lansing Appeal hearing of August 14, 2012, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Team Red Dawn LLC, 2536 Henry, Muskegon, Muskegon County

The penalty hearing was conducted for Team Red Dawn LLC, Business ID# 222767. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, and member, Mary Caruso appeared on behalf of the applicant. Also present was Joseph Grimm, spouse of member and manager at the business. Ms. Hetzel, Ms. Caruso and Mr. Grimm offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to suspend the license for three (3) consecutive days, with the dates of the suspension being August 31, September 1 and 2, 2012, with the license to remain in escrow. Supported by Commissioner Olshove, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney advised that this matter would be tabled for a hearing at a future date, to allow for further review of the file.
