Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:08 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Lansing Appeal hearing of August 21, 2012, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Perr's Pub, Inc., 301 N Hamilton, Saginaw, Saginaw County  
Complaint # 1-149182

The violation hearing was conducted for Perr's Pub, Inc., Complaint # 1-149182. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Attorney L. William Smith appeared on behalf of the licensee. Stockholder, Michael Perry absent for health reasons. Ms. Hetzel and Mr. Smith offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to deny the appeal of the licensee and affirm the decision as set forth in the original order of Hearing Commissioner Colleen A. Pobur, dated June 8, 2012. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. Shah, LLC, 2400 NW Alpine, Walker, Kent County Request ID# 654683

The church hearing was conducted for Shah, LLC, Request ID# 654683. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney G. Sal Gani, and member, Inderjit Singh appeared on behalf of the applicant. Present for the Living Hope Community Church was James Hogg, Senior Pastor. Ms. Hetzel, Mr. Gani and Pastor Hogg offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on

the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion that the findings of the Commission are that the church filed a proper objection to the issuance of the license, the burden of proceeding was placed on the applicant, and that the applicant has not shown by competent, material and substantial evidence that the issuance of a Specially Designated Distributor license would not adversely affect the objecting church. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:17 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
