1. Marathon Flint Oil Company, 2320 Davison, Flint, Genesee County,
Complaint #1-146169

The appeal hearing was conducted for Marathon Flint Oil Company, Complaint #1-146169. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Attorney Roger Isaac appeared on behalf of the licensee. Mr. Hall and Mr. Isaac offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, the matter was tabled until the next Lansing Appeal Hearing.

2. Royal Medical & Technical Consultants Inc., 9285 W. Lake, Houghton Lake,
Roscommon Township, Roscommon County, Request ID# 533661

The licensing hearing was conducted for Royal Medical & Technical Consultants Inc., Request ID# 533661. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Sheriff Randall Stevenson appeared on behalf of the Roscommon County Sheriff's Department and Attorney G. Sal Gani appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Hall indicated that this request was being taken out of order as the attorney for the applicant is requesting an adjournment. Mr. Gani advised the Commission that an adjournment was being requested as the applicant for the license could not appear due to health issues. After discussion on the record, an adjournment was granted so all concerned parties could appear at a rescheduled hearing.

3. Khasria, LLC, 158 Main, Eaton Rapids, Eaton County, Request ID# 608728

The licensing hearing was conducted for Khasria, LLC, 158 Main, Eaton Rapids, Eaton County, Request ID# 608728. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Chief Paul Malewski appeared on behalf of the Eaton Rapids Police

Department and Attorney Roger Isaac appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Hall, Chief Malewski and Mr. Roger Isaac offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, it was ruled that the Commission Order be upheld. Commissioner Weatherspoon made a motion to affirm the Commission Order dated June 16, 2011, which denied the applicant's request for a new Specially Designated Merchant license (SDM) and Sunday Sales Permit (A.M.). Commissioner Quimby supported and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.
