Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:46 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Southfield Appeal Hearing of August 2, 2012, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Nadas, Inc., 30990 Dequindre, Warren, Macomb County Request ID# 654121

The licensing hearing was conducted for Nadas, Inc., Request ID# 654121. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Joseph A. Garcia and Loai Kasyouhanan, stockholder, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Asevedo and Mr. Garcia offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney advised the matter was tabled to a future date.

3. M-15, LLC, 10081 Ortonville, Clarkston, Independence Township, Oakland County Request ID# 630349

The licensing hearing was conducted for M-15, LLC, Request ID# 630349. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Attorney Jonathan Walton, Jr., appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Asevedo and Mr. Walton offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated June 5, 2012, and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer ownership of escrowed 2012 Class C license with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.), Outdoor Service (1 area), and Specific Purpose Permit (Food) from SAS Dining, Inc.; transfer location (governmental unit) under MCL 436.1531(1) from 57721 Grand River, New Hudson, Lyon Township, Oakland County; cancel existing Outdoor Service (1 area); and request authorization for the outdoor sale, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages in an area measuring up to 9' X 56', located directly adjacent to the licensed premises, with license and permits to remain in escrow. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. SYI, Inc., 22030 Farmington, Farmington, Oakland County Request ID# 634638

The licensing hearing was conducted for SYI, Inc., Request ID# 634638. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Mark Chiesa and Simon Yi, stockholder, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Asevedo and Mr. Chiesa offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated June 27, 2012, and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer ownership of escrowed 2012 Resort Class C license issued under the provisions of MCL 436.1531(2) with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.), Dance-Entertainment Permit, Specific Purpose Permit (Food) and Outdoor Service (1 area) from Grand Traverse Bay Entertainment, L.L.C.; request transfer location (governmental unit) from 626 E. Front, Traverse City, Grand Traverse County; request to cancel existing Dance-Entertainment Permit; cancel existing Outdoor Service (1 area); request new Specially Designated Merchant license; and request authorization to sell alcoholic liquor between 7 A.M. and Noon on Sundays. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

5. Andary Enterprises, Inc., 14800 E. Seven Mile, Detroit, Wayne County  
Request ID# 417578

The licensing hearing was conducted for Andary Enterprises, Inc., Request ID# 417578. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Attorney Raymond J. Andary, appeared on behalf of the licensee. Mr. Asevedo and Mr. Andary offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated June 27, 2012, and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, for an extension of escrow until December 31, 2012 for the 2011 Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.) and Dance Permit. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 12:07 p.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
