Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:07 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Lansing Appeal hearing of September 4, 2012, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. M & RK, Inc., 25142 Red Arrow, Mattawan, Antwerp Township, Van Buren County
Request ID# 655021

The licensing hearing was conducted for M & RK, Inc., Request ID# 655021. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Gary Tibble and stockholder, Gian Singh appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Hetzel, Mr. Tibble and Mr. Singh offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated July 18, 2012 and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer ownership of 2012 Specially Designated Distributor and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales (A.M. and P.M.), from S & G Store, LLC. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. Cavette Enterprises, Inc., 6801 N Saginaw, Flint, Genesee County
Request ID# 659712

The Church hearing was conducted for Cavette Enterprises, Inc., Request ID# 659712. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, no one was present on behalf of the applicant and no one was present on behalf of the objecting church, Bethlehem Temple Church. Ms. Hetzel offered comments

regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney advised we had received a written request from stockholder, Jerry Cavette, to cancel the church hearing as he was amending the transferring location request to reflect a different address than the Commission record shows. Chairman Deloney made a motion that the church hearing be adjourned, Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. Time Consuming, LLC, 1001 S Madison, Bay City, Bay County
Business ID# 223038

The show cause hearing was conducted for Time Consuming, LLC, Business ID# 223038. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, stockholder Guy Garcia appeared on behalf of the licensee, and landlord Michael Garcia was also present. Ms. Hetzel, Mr. G. Garcia and Mr. M. Garcia offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to immediately suspend the 2012 Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.), as set forth in the Show Cause Hearing Order, with the licenses to be held in escrow pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Rule R 436.1107. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:28 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
