Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:05 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, to approve the Southfield Appeal minutes from October 6, 2011, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Venita M Gordon, 5331 Chene, Detroit, Wayne County Request ID #329886

The licensing hearing was tabled on September 29, 2011 for Venita M. Gordon, Request ID# 329886. Linda Pytel-McDowell appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, and Venita M. Gordon appeared on behalf of herself. Ms. Pytel-McDowell and Ms. Gordon offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, the matter was tabled for a hearing at a future date.

3. Diane's Party Store, Inc. 8700 Schaeffer, Detroit, Wayne County
Business ID# 12522

The penalty hearing was conducted for Diane's Party Store, Inc., Business ID# 12522. Linda Pytel-McDowell appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, and Attorney Joseph Shallal appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Pytel-McDowell and Mr. Shallal offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to suspend the license for five days and waive 2 days of the suspension because of time already served. This suspension would start on October 24, 2011 and conclude on October 26, 2011. The waived dates are October 27 and October 28, 2011. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #123, 5841 Telegraph, Taylor, Wayne County

The licensing hearing was conducted for Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #123, 5841 Telegraph, Taylor, Wayne County, Request ID#566627. Linda Pytel-McDowell appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Matthew Minard appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Pytel-McDowell and Mr. Minard offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Order of the Commission dated August 10, 2011 and grant a request for new Club license and new Specially Designated Merchant licenses to be held in conjunction with the new Club license that will limit sales from the SDM license to club members only. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

5. ASF OF FLINT, INC., 3500 N. State, Davison, Genesee County

A. The licensing hearing was conducted for ASF OF FLINT, INC., Request ID# 610064. Linda Pytel-McDowell appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Attorney Michael Jablonski appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Pytel-McDowell and Mr. Jablonski offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the Commission Order dated August 31, 2011 and grant a transfer ownership of the 2011 Specially Designated Distributor license with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.), transfer location, and change nature of business to include motor vehicle fuel pumps. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

Linda Pytel-McDowell appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Attorney Michael Jablonski appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Pytel-McDowell and Mr. Jablonski offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the Order of the Commission dated August 31, 2011 and grant a new Specially Designated Merchant license with Sunday Sales Permit (A.M.) and motor vehicle fuel pumps. Commissioner Quimby supported and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.
