Molloy provided a handout that explained the education and testing requirements of Registered Dental Assistants, as well as the various functions they perform under delegation and supervision. A second handout contained a table of the supervised functions RDAs perform under assignment, general supervision, and direct supervision. This table reflects the same information contained in the rules, but is displayed in an easy-to-understand manner.

Roels explained that she provides services for a population of patients with exceptionally poor oral health. She relies on the services of RDAs and believes that if additional functions were allowed to be delegated to RDAs, she could increase the number of people being served.

NEW BUSINESS

Administrative Rules for Human Trafficking and Pain and Symptom Management

Barr advised the board that their administrative rules would need to be modified to address the new statutory requirement for licensees to complete training in Human Trafficking, as well as the revised continuing education recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Pain and Symptom Management. The Rules Committee will be tasked with reviewing these rules, as well as relicensure rules and specialty examination rules.

MOTION by Briskie, seconded by Manos, to open the administrative rules for review and task the review of the rules to the Rules Committee.

Specialty Examinations - Equivalency

The Council of Michigan Dental Specialties (CMDS) for the specialty fields of Orthodontics, Periodontics, and Endodontics requested the following examinations be considered substantially equivalent to the specialty examinations administered by the State:

- Endodontists will rely on the American Board of Endodontics written examination
- Orthodontists will rely on the American Board of Orthodontics written examinations
- Periodontists will rely on the in-service evaluative process mandated by ADA-CODA accredited programs. This specialty is satisfied that the standardized, rigorous, mandated evaluative process used during the course of the accredited specialty residency required for graduation is a sufficient demonstration of minimum competency to practice this specialty.

R 338.11267(2) provides the criteria the Board must use to determine whether the exams listed above are substantially equivalent to the current State exam. To determine substantial equivalency, the board shall consider such factors as the following:

- Subject areas included.
- Detail of material.
- Comprehensiveness.
- Length of the examination.
- Degree of difficulty.

Richard Small, representing the CMDS, provided background information and rationale for Board members to consider in making their decision.

MOTION by Kaysserian, seconded by Wright to approve the request for exam equivalency, beginning with fiscal year (FY'16).
