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The meeting was called to order by Chairman Deloney at 11:10 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

- I. **Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Commission meeting of March 25, 2014, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.**
- II. Ms. Hamilton presented licensee requests for special price reductions on spirit products in accordance with the provisions of the Commission's Order of September 11, 2012 regarding special price reductions on spirit products, which was effective on January 1, 2013. She advised there were forty five (45) different licensees requesting price reductions; that 925 product price reductions could be approved; and that there were zero product price reduction to be denied.  
  
**Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the 925 special price reductions be approved as indicated on the attached Approval for Price Reduction on Liquor reports, motion carried by unanimous vote.**
- III. Mr. Robinson presented the February 2014 Financial Report which shows the results of our operations for the period of October 1, 2013 through February 28, 2014 and advised that this report contains three extra sales days when compared with the report for February 2013. He reported the Total Gross Sales increased over last year by almost \$17.2 million or 3.76% higher, and the Distilled Spirit cases sold increased 23,460 or 0.7%. Mr. Robinson advised the Net Income from spirit sales increased approximately \$1.4 million or 2.0%, and that Beer taxes are higher by \$597,000, with Wine taxes being slightly higher by \$1935.

**Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the February 2014 Financial Report, be accepted, motion carried by unanimous vote.**

- IV. Mr. Robinson requested approval to write off a number of uncollectible accounts. He advised this is routine information sent to the Michigan Department of Treasury regarding outstanding debts that the Commission has not been able to collect for licensees that are no longer active. Mr. Robinson stated that the Michigan Department of Treasury will attempt to collect the debt and if successful, the Commission receives 40% to 50% of the outstanding debt.

**Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the information concerning the uncollectible debts be forwarded to the Michigan Department of Treasury for collection, as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.**

- III. Ms. Hamilton presented licensee requests for special price reductions on spirit products in accordance with the provisions of the Commission's Order of September 11, 2012 regarding special price reductions on spirit products, which was effective on January 1, 2013. She advised there were seventy-five (75) different licensees requesting price reductions; and that 5437 product price reductions could be approved; and that there were zero product price reductions to be denied.

**Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Olshove, that the 5437 special price reductions be approved as indicated on the attached Approval for Price Reduction on Liquor report, motion carried by unanimous vote.**

- IV. Mr. Robinson presented the March 2014 Financial Report which shows the results of our operations for the period of October 1, 2013 through March 31, 2014 and advised that this report contains three extra sales days when compared with the report for March 2013. He reported the Total Gross Sales increased over last year by almost \$20.5 million or 3.8% higher, and the Distilled Spirit cases sold increased 34,001 or 0.9%. Mr. Robinson advised the Net Income from spirit sales increased approximately \$2.48 million or 3.0%, Beer taxes are higher by \$367,000, with Wine taxes being higher by almost \$161,000.

**Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Olshove, that the March 2014 Financial Report, be accepted, motion carried by unanimous vote.**

- V. Commissioner Quimby advised that a request for a declaratory ruling was received from James Crank on behalf of Cranker's Restaurant & Brewery on April 24, 2014 and that the Commission, under administrative rule R 436.1973(1), has 30 days to notify Mr. Crank whether a declaratory ruling will be issued. She stated Mr. Crank is requesting the Commission issue a declaratory ruling on MCL 436.1411(2) which allows a licensed micro brewer who has more than 1 licensed brewery premises, to sell for on-premises consumption, beer that it has produced at one licensed brewery, at any of its other licensed brewery premises. Mr. Crank has two licensed micro brewer locations held in different corporate names with Mr. Crank being the sole stockholder of both corporations.

Commissioner Quimby stated an interested person may request a declaratory ruling from the Commission by written request, which Mr. Crank has done; that the written request shall contain the relevant and material facts along with a reference to the statute or rule, which Mr. Crank has done.

**Motion made by Commissioner Quimby to grant the request to issue a declaratory ruling on MCL 436.1411(2) of the Michigan Administrative Code, supported by Commissioner Olshove, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.**

Commissioner Quimby announced that under administrative rule R 436.1973(2) the Commission is obligated to issue the declaratory ruling within 90 days which is no later than July 23, 2014. She invited anyone that wishes to submit written comments for Commission consideration to do so on or before May 24, 2014.
