	R 400.8810 Swimming caregiver-to-child ratio.
	(1) The center obtains and keeps on file written parental permission regarding swimming activities.
	(2) A lifeguard is on duty at all swimming activities as is not be included in the ratio.
	(3) For children under 3 years of age, the in-the-water ratio is 1:1.
	(4) For all nonswimmers 3 years of age and older, the in-the-water ratio is 1:4 when the water level is chest height or lower. When the water level is above the chest height, the in-the-water ratio is 1:1.
	(5) For swimmers 3 years of age and older, the in-the-water ratio meets requirements in R 400.8182(3)
	R 400.8820 Swimming activity supervision.
	(1) Child care staff members counted in ratio are:
	(a) Actively engaged in providing direct care, supervision, and guidance.
	(b) Physically able to assist children quickly.
	R 400.8830 Instructional swim.
	(1) Instructional swim is conducted under the supervision of a qualified water safety instructor (WSI).
	(2) The ratios under R 400.8182(3) are maintained. The instructor is not included in the ratio.
	R 400.8840 Swimming activity area.
	(1) All swimming areas are to be maintained in a clean and safe condition.
	(2) The public swimming pool is inspected by the local health department and license issued by DEQ.
	(3) Before using a public or private beach, the center assures the water has not been deemed unsafe by the local health department.
	(4) A working phone is accessible on the premises.
_	 (5) Following safety equipment are accessible:
	(a) First aid kit.
	(b) Rescue pole or throwing rope and ring buoy.
	(c) Signaling device.
	(6) Private wading pools and hot tubs are prohibited.
