SHOW CAUSE HEARING ORDER

On December 13, 2011, C & S Management Co. Inc. (licensee) filed a request for a new SDM license with permission for motor vehicle fuel pumps under MCL 436.1541(1), to be held at the above-noted location. The request was approved by the Commission on July 5, 2012 with the proviso that the licensee install and continue to maintain on the licensed premises at all times, a minimum inventory of at least \$250,000.00, at cost, excluding alcoholic liquor and motor vehicle fuel as required by MCL 436.1541(1)(a)(ii). The SDM license was issued on October 5, 2012.

On February 20, 2013 an inspection was conducted by the Commission's Enforcement Division and it was determined that the applicant's approved type inventory, at cost, was below the \$250,000.00 requirement under MCL 436.1541(1)(a)(ii). On March 27, 2013, the Commission issued an Order to Show Cause under administrative rule R 436.1925(1), to determine the status of the SDM license, and any or all other issues

related to the license, permits and permissions.

The Commission held the show cause hearing in this matter on April 30, 2013 at its Lansing office. Representing the licensee at the hearing were stockholders Charles and Susan Christian. After hearing arguments, reviewing the MLCC file, and discussion of the issue on the record, the Commission finds that the applicant demonstrated good cause in which to suspend the subject license until the licensee can demonstrate that a minimum inventory of at least \$250,000.00, at cost, excluding alcoholic liquor and motor vehicle fuel as required by MCL 436.1541(1)(a)(ii), has been installed on the premises.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the SDM license with permission for motor vehicle fuel pumps under MCL 436.1541(1) held by C & S Management Co. Inc. at the above-noted location, is SUSPENDED until the licensee can demonstrate that a minimum inventory of at least \$250,000.00, at cost, excluding alcoholic liquor and motor vehicle fuel as required by MCL 436.1541(1)(a)(ii), has been installed on the premises.
