

FINAL ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST

1. On February 22, 2012, the Chief Deputy Commissioner issued an Order to Cease and desist (hereafter "Order") pursuant to Section 251 of the Michigan Insurance Code, (hereafter "Code"), MCL 500.251, against Respondents National Processing Center and Christopher J. Covington.
2. The Order contained allegations that Respondents violated various sections of the Code.
3. On February 22, 2012, the Order was mailed to National Processing Center via certified mail to the business address as maintained by the US Postal Service.
4. On February 22, 2012, the Order was mailed to Christopher Covington at his last known address as maintained by the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles. All letters were returned "unclaimed."

5. The Order advised the Respondents of the opportunity to request a hearing on the Order, as provided in Section 251 of the Code, MCL 500.251, not later than 30 days after the Order was delivered or mailed to Respondents.
6. Respondents failed to timely request a hearing, therefore the Order is **FINAL**.
