

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

In The Matter Of:
Alysse Crum
Registration #: DF780361975

On November 16, 2015, the Bureau of Community and Health Systems issued an *Order of Summary Suspension and Notice of Intent To Revoke* the family child care home certificate of registration of Alysse Crum.

In settlement of all issues raised in the *Order of Summary Suspension and Notice of Intent to Revoke*, the undersigned parties hereby agree:

- 1) Alysse Crum denies the allegations in paragraphs 3(c), 3(d), 3(e), 3(f), 3(g), and 4 in the *Order of Summary Suspension and Notice of Intent To Revoke*. Ms. Crum also denies the allegation in paragraph 3(a) to the extent that it states the incident occurred before 5:00 p.m. Ms. Crum maintains it occurred after 5:00 p.m. but before Child B and Child C were to be picked up from her family child care home.
- 2) Alysse Crum does not contest the allegations in the remaining paragraphs in the *Order* and agrees that the Bureau may treat the remaining allegations of fact and law as true, which finding shall have the same force and effect for purposes of this *Agreement* as if evidence and argument were presented in support of the allegations.
- 3) Alysse Crum understands that her family child care home certificate of registration will be revoked for a period of eight months, effective December 1, 2015, after which time Ms. Crum may reapply for a license or certificate of registration. Ms. Crum represents that she ceased providing care to unrelated children in her home for pay on November 16, 2015.
- 4) Alysse Crum understands that under MCL 722.125, Section 15(1), a person who provides child care without a license or certificate of registration is guilty of a misdemeanor, and the offense is punishable by up to 90 days imprisonment and/or a \$1,000 fine.
- 5) Alysse Crum understands that she is waiving her right to appeal the *Order of Summary Suspension and Notice of Intent To Revoke* her certificate of registration, and an administrative hearing will not be held in this matter.
