After discussion on the record, Commissioner Quimby made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of Denial dated November 25, 2014, and to approve the request for a new Micro Brewer license, as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order. Commissioner Olshove supported and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Quimby and supported by Commissioner Olshove, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:26 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
