The State of Michigan will be replacing the Michigan Automated Prescription System (MAPS) with Appriss, PMP AWARxE software, effective **tomorrow**. Please begin your data submissions to PMP Clearinghouse tomorrow, **April 4, 2017**.

If you have not already done so, please go to <https://pmpclearinghouse.net> and click on *Create Account* to begin registration. If you already have an account with Appriss' PMP Clearinghouse, you do not need to re-register.
