Dear MAPS User:

The State of Michigan will be replacing the Michigan Automated Prescription System (MAPS) with Appriss, PMP AWARxE software, effective **April 4, 2017.**

<u>Pre-registration is now open!</u> Please find important information below, and refer to the attached <u>MAPS</u> <u>AWARxE User Registration Process</u> for additional guidance.

Key Dates to Remember	
March 9, 2017:	Registration to PMP AWARxE available. Please go to <u>https://michigan.pmpaware.net/login</u> and click on <i>Create Account</i> to begin registration.
April 3, 2017: April 4, 2017:	Last day to submit requests and/or file submissions to the existing MAPS. All requests and reporting must go through the new system. Current MAPS accounts will no longer be accessible.
Important Registration Information	

- Accounts from the current MAPS will not be transferred to the new system.
- Only one user account is allowed per email address.
- Mid-level Physicians (Nurse Practitioners, Nurse Midwives, and Physician Assistants): A health
 professional license and DEA registration are required to register as a non-delegate user. If you do
 not hold a DEA registration, registration is only allowed as a Prescriber Delegate Licensed user
 role to request reports on behalf of the physician.
- If registering as a Delegate user, your Supervisor must complete registration first.
- Your health professional license, controlled substance license (if applicable), National Provider Identifier (NPI), and DEA registration numbers are required for registration.
- If your registration is approved prior to 4/4/2017, you will be able to log into the application but you will NOT be able to run patient reports until 4/4/2017.

You will receive a reminder email regarding the MAPS transition to PMP AWARxE in early April. Technical assistance is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.
