R 408.11119 and R 408.11121 of the Michigan Administrative Code are rescinded as follows:

PART 11. POLISHING, BUFFING & ABRADING

R 408.11119 ~~Lock out and stop devices.~~ **Rescinded.**

~~Rule 1119. (1) Automatic equipment shall be provided with power lock out devices which shall be used to prevent inadvertent operation of the equipment.~~

~~(2) Emergency stop buttons or cords shall be provided along the line of heads and be accessible to the operator.~~

R 408.11121 ~~Fixtures.~~ **Rescinded.**

~~Rule 1121. Auxiliary equipment designed as a standing fixture shall be secured to the floor or machine.~~
