LICENSING APPEAL ORDER

On August 20, 2012, Graham Market, Inc. (applicant) filed a request to transfer ownership of 2012 SDD and SDM licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (A.M.) and Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.) from Kallo Investment, Inc., to be held at the above noted address.

At a meeting held on December 19, 2012, the Commission denied this request under administrative rule R 436.1105(2)(a) after considering that applicant stockholder, Ziad A. Arabo, is currently licensed by the Commission and has an extensive violation history, including two (2) violations of the sale of alcoholic liquor to a person under 21 years of age (16 years old and 18 years old), and four (4) violations of the sale of tobacco to a person under 18 years of age (12 years old, 14 years old, and two (2) incidents involving 17 year old minors).

Peter Abbo, legal counsel on behalf of the applicant, submitted a timely request for an appeal in this matter and represented the applicant at the February 14, 2013 hearing, held at the Commission’s Southfield office.

After hearing arguments, reviewing the MLCC file and documents presented, and discussion of the issue on the record, the Commission does not find error with the

application of the MLCC Code or Administrative Rules.

Under Article IV, Section 40, of the Constitution of Michigan (1963), the Commission shall exercise complete control of the alcoholic beverage traffic within this state, including the retail sales thereof, subject to statutory limitations. Further, the Commission shall have the sole right, power, and duty to control the alcoholic beverage traffic and traffic in other alcoholic liquor within this state, including the manufacture, importation, possession, transportation and sale thereof under MCL 436.1201(2).

For the reasons stated on the record, the previous order is affirmed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the denial order of December 19, 2012 issued in this matter is AFFIRMED.
