Suburban Collection Showplace in Novi is located at 46100 Grand River Avenue, between Novi and Beck Road just off the newly rebuilt Beck Road exit from I-96.

From the North (Gaylord area)

Take US-131, US-27 or US-23 South to I-96 East; follow Exit 160. Go south onto Beck Rd. Turn left onto Grand River Ave. and go approximately 1/2 mile down on your left hand side.

From the West: (Lansing area)

Take I-96 East; follow Exit 160. Go south onto Beck Rd. Turn left onto Grand River Ave. and go approximately 1/2 mile down on the left hand side.

From the South (Detroit area)

Take US-23 North to M-14 East to 275 North to I-96 West; follow Exit 160. Go south onto Beck Rd. Turn left onto Grand River Ave. and go approximately 1/2 mile down on your left hand side.

From the East:

Take I-96 West, follow Exit 160. Go south onto Beck Rd. Turn left onto Grand River Ave. and go approximately 1/2 mile down on your left hand side.
