



establish a Liquor Control Commission, which shall exercise complete control of the alcoholic beverage traffic within this state, including the retail sales thereof, subject to statutory limitations. MCL 436.1201(2) provides the Commission with the sole right, power, and duty to control the alcoholic beverage traffic and traffic in other alcoholic liquor within this state, including the manufacture, importation, possession, transportation and sale thereof.

After reviewing the MLCC file and discussion of the issue on the record, the Commission does not find error with the application of the MLCC Code or Administrative Rules. For the reasons stated on the record, the previous order is affirmed.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the denial order of October 8, 2014 issued in this matter is AFFIRMED.
