



The Commission also denied this request under administrative rule R 436.1105(2)(j) after considering the effects that issuance of a license would have on the health, welfare, and safety of the general public when determining whether an applicant should be issued a license or permit.

Peter Abbo, legal counsel on behalf of the applicant, submitted a timely request for an appeal in this matter and represented the applicant at the February 26, 2015 hearing, held at the Commission's Southfield office.

After hearing arguments, reviewing the MLCC file and documents presented, and discussion of the issue on the record, the Commission finds that this application should be returned to Commission staff for further processing.


