Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:05 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Southfield Appeal Hearings of September 5, 2013, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.

2. Sakim Inc., 23471 Eureka Road, Taylor, Wayne County Request ID# 674310

The licensing hearing was held for Sakim Inc., Request ID# 674310. Susan Moody appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Attorney Scott D. MacDonald appeared on behalf of the applicant. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated June 19, 2013 in part, and approve the request to transfer ownership of escrowed 2013 Class C license from Pizza Hut of America, Inc. (A Delaware Corporation); transfer location (governmental unit) under MCL 436.1531(1) from 2121 Dix, Lincoln Park, Wayne County; request authorization for the sale of spirits and mixed spirit drink for consumption on the premises after 12:00 Noon on Sundays; and affirm the denial for a request authorization for the outdoor sale, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages, as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order. Commissioner Quimby supported and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. Bossy B's Bar & Grill Inc., 14700 E. Seven Mile, Detroit, Wayne County Request ID# 672380

The licensing hearing was held for Bossy B's Bar & Grill Inc., Request ID# 672380, which was originally scheduled on July 18, 2013, but postponed at the request of Cassie Bass. Susan Moody appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and no one appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Moody offered comments regarding this case and noted on the record that the applicant was properly notified of the hearing. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to affirm the previous Commission Order of denial dated May 8, 2013, and deny the request to transfer ownership of escrowed 2013 Class C and Specially Designated Merchant license with Sunday Sale Permit (P.M.), Dance-Entertainment Permit, and Outdoor Service (1 area) from the Estate of James Dixon, Jr. and Wanda L. Bowen-Dixon, as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order. Commissioner Olshove supported and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 10:53 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
