Commissioner Quimby called the hearings to order at 10:08 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Olshove, that the minutes of the Southfield Appeal Hearings of September 12, 2013, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. The hearing for Battle Creek Hotels, LLC, Request ID# 673828, scheduled for today, has been postponed.
3. Peter & Son, Inc., 12868 Eureka, Southgate, Wayne County Request ID# 699017

The licensing hearing was held for Peter & Son, Inc., Request ID# 699017, which was originally scheduled on August 29, 2013, but was postponed at the request of Attorney Shallal. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Joseph Shallal and Louie Betti, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Asevedo, Mr. Shallal and Mr. Betti offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Commissioner Quimby made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated July 17, 2013, and approve the request to transfer all stock interest in 2013 Specially Designated Distributor and Specially Designated Merchant licensed business with Sunday Sales (P.M.), as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order. Commissioner Olshove supported and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. Gina's Breakfast & Soul Food, Inc., 18000 Vernier, Store #101, Harper Woods, Wayne County Request ID# 699060

The licensing hearing was held for Gina's Breakfast & Soul Food, Inc., Request ID# 699060. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office

and Regina Russell-Pratt appeared on behalf of the applicant. Also present was Eugene Pratt, husband of the applicant. Mr. Asevedo, Ms. Russell-Pratt and Mr. Pratt offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Commissioner Quimby made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated July 24, 2013 and remand the file back to the Licensing Division, as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order. Commissioner Olshove supported and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

5. Lynnann Residential Treatment Facility, Inc. 15410 W. Chicago, Detroit, Wayne County Request ID# 699274

The licensing hearing was held for Lynnann Residential Treatment Facility, Inc., Request ID# 699274. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Alyce Lipkin appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Asevdo and Ms. Lipkin offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Commissioner Quimby advised the matter would be tabled to a hearing on a future date to allow the applicant to obtain legal counsel.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Olshove, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:30 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
