The Licensing Meeting was called to order at 10:57 a.m. Present were Chairman Deloney, Commissioner Quimby and Commissioner Weatherspoon.

The first item of business was to address the Appeal Hearing held earlier for San Miguel Market, LLC, Request ID# 572722. The matter was reconvened for the reason that the applicant had checked into the building on time, but due to a miscommunication by the first floor Security desk to the Michigan Liquor Control Commission, the applicant was not escorted to the hearing site.

1. The licensing hearing was conducted for San Miguel Market, LLC, Request ID# 572722. Jerry Whalen appeared on behalf of the Department of Attorney General and Maria Juana Rojano Campo was present on behalf of the applicant. Rosemary Castro appeared as Ms. Rojano's interpreter for the reason that she did not speak English. Motion made by Chairman Deloney to reverse the previous order that affirmed the Commission's Denial Order dated September 28, 2011. Commissioner Weatherspoon supported, motion carried by unanimous vote.

Mr. Whalen and Ms. Campo (thru interpreter, Rosemary Castro) offered comments regarding this case. Chairman Deloney noted that our file shows that Ms. Campo's daughter and son-in-law would be running the business, that they are undocumented aliens with no legal status in the United States, and that no information was provided to the contrary. Ms. Castro confirmed that finding and did not offer any further information to add to the licensing file. After discussion on the record, Commissioner Quimby moved to affirm the Commission Order dated September 28, 2011, denying the request for a new Specially Designated Merchant license. Commissioner Weatherspoon supported, the motion carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Chairman Deloney, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings portion of the Licensing Meeting be recessed at 11:16 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote. The Commission then continued its Licensing Meeting.

Chairman Deloney called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m. noting that a quorum was present.
