



ADMINISTRATIVE
MEETING OF THE
MICHIGAN LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Deloney at 9:04 a.m., noting a quorum was present. Chairman Deloney recognized Joe Cekola, President of CKL Corporation, d/b/a Imperial Beverage who had filed an application for a Commission appointment as an Authorized Distribution Agent license (ADA) for the Michigan Liquor Control Commission (MLCC).

Mr. Cekola provided the Commission with an overview of the company history and their plan as set forth in their ADA application. After the presentation, Chairman Deloney thanked Mr. Cekola for providing information to the Commission and noted that the appointment was still under review.

Harold McGovern, President of NWS Michigan, briefly spoke on the issue, noting that all ADA's should fall under the same requirements and be held to the same standards. Michael Rosch, Executive Vice President of Great Lakes Wine & Spirits, briefly spoke on the issue, noting the same concerns as Mr. McGovern and that there are some huge expenses that have not been addressed.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, that the meeting be adjourned at 9:37 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
