Kelly Allen, legal counsel on behalf of the licensee submitted a request to amend the licensing approval order of May 11, 2010 by removing the provision to install privacy fencing between the adjoining property of the applicant's location and the church located next door.

The Commission also amended the approval order by striking the requirement of a final inspection by the Hamburg Township Police Department, and by including the following requirements:

- Must provide proof of financial responsibility under MCL 436.1803
- Must submit proof of Server Training under MCL 436.1501(1) within 180 days from issuance of the license and permits as provided in administrative rule R 436.1060
- Must comply with administrative rule R 436.1003
- Failure to comply with all requirements of licensure in the State of Michigan will result in the licensee being charged with a violation of the MLCC Code and Administrative Rules

Jaspal Singh, member on behalf of the licensee, submitted a request to amend the licensing approval order of March 10, 2011 by removing the provision that the licenses and permit must be placed into active operation within one (1) year from the date of the order, and failure to comply by that date shall result in the order being vacated.

The Commission also amended the approval order by striking the requirement of a final inspection by the Kalamazoo County Sheriff Department, and by striking the requirement to provide documentary proof of server training and electronic scanning equipment.

- Must provide proof of financial responsibility under MCL 436.1803
- Must comply with administrative rule R 436.1003
- Failure to comply with all requirements of licensure in the State of Michigan will result in the licensee being charged with a violation of the MLCC Code and Administrative Rules
