The programs / courses that are currently being offered at MCTI EAST:

➤ **Career Readiness Center**

5 to 10 Week program offering a variety of assessments, structured programs, & classes. Prepares students to enter a vocational trade program that matches their skills & interest and builds employability skills prior to entering a trade program and/or employment. Students will develop & complete an Educational Development Plan (EDP). Mandatory for new students at MCTI.

➤ **Certified Nurse Assistant**

10 Week program provides the student with the necessary skills to seek employment in a long-term care facility as a Certified Nurses Assistant. Students first learn patient care techniques in a simulated lab environment followed by a clinical rotation at a nursing home. Upon completion of the program, students are offered study and practice sessions to prepare for the State of Michigan competency exam.

➤ **Pharmacy Technician**

This 18 week program is a partnership with CVS located at WCCCD – Eastern Campus. Students selected for this trade will complete a 6 week OJT with a training wage of \$8.00 while receiving hands on experience in receiving, processing, and distributing prescriptions in the pharmacy. After successful completion of the OJT, students will enter into Supported Employment for an additional 12 weeks earning a wage of \$8.50.

➤ **Building Trades**

This is currently a 10 Week program that exposes students to a variety of the building trades through both classroom and hands on training. Students will learn skills in carpentry, painting, drywall, electrical, plumbing, and demolition. In addition, key instructional components of the program include construction math, self employment & empowerment.

➤ **Applied Technology - NEW**

This 10 week program has a well-equipped industry standard technical lab that provides up to date hands on training. Students in the program learn entry level skills appropriate to most manufacturing businesses and industries. Courses help prepare students for entry level employment in industrial maintenance. Career Choices includes but not limited to: Assembler/Tester, Industrial Tester/ Installer, Alarms Technician and Alternative Energy Technician.

➤ **Employer Based Training (EBT) – Janitorial**

6 Week non paid internship to provide students with hands on experience in daily cleaning and floor maintenance, stripping of floors, restroom sanitation, daily carpet cleaning and shampooing, and using and maintaining equipment. Excellent for students with little to no recent work experience in the field.
