RE: Statement from the Alabama State Board of Pharmacy – Recall Notice

The Alabama State Board of Pharmacy requested that NABP provide the following important notice to the executive officers of state boards of pharmacy. The Board is working with the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) on this situation.

“As of September 3, 2015, mediStat Pharmacy, a 503b outsourcing facility in Foley Alabama, has initiated a national recall of all sterile injectable products manufactured between November 2014 and the present. The recall is based on the identification of various pathogens within the compounding environment. To date, there has not been an instance of a contaminated product, nor has there been a patient identified, who has been affected by any of the pathogens found in the compounding environment. If a physician’s office has any of the vials which meet the recall criteria, the office should return the product to mediStat, 110 E Azalea Avenue, Foley Al 36535. Likewise, if purchasers of these products are aware of any patient involvement with adverse reactions, please complete a report using the FDA Adverse Event Reporting System (FAERS).”
