

rule R 436.1925(1), to determine the status of the SDM license, and any or all other issues related to the license, permits and permissions.

The Commission held the show cause hearing in this matter on March 7, 2013 at its Southfield office. Representing the licensee at the hearing was Attorney Samir Mashni and sole member, Boulos Mashni.

After hearing arguments, reviewing the MLCC file, and discussion of the issue on the record, the Commission finds that the applicant demonstrated good cause in which to suspend the subject license and permits until the licensee can demonstrate that a minimum inventory of at least \$250,000.00, at cost, excluding alcoholic liquor and motor vehicle fuel as required by MCL 436.1541(1)(a)(ii), has been installed on the premises.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the 2012 SDM license with permission for motor vehicle fuel pumps under MCL 436.1541(1) and Sunday Sales Permit (A.M.) held by Maraj Development Company LLC at the above-noted location, is SUSPENDED until the licensee can demonstrate that a minimum inventory of at least \$250,000.00, at cost, excluding alcoholic liquor and motor vehicle fuel as required by MCL 436.1541(1)(a)(ii), has been installed on the premises.
