Course Description: The Oakland Fire Training Institute offers a unique training experience that provides firefighters with the best live fire training program currently available to the fire service that can be transported to your community.

The Phase I Mobile Flashover Unit constructed by Swede Survival Systems is a laboratory; where fire behavior can be observe three feet below the fire floor. Instructors will demonstrate basic fire behavior using Class A combustible. The fire is not influenced by artificial or individual factors and is the most cost effective, realistic fire training available.

Key points of the system include incipient phase of the fire, fire growth, smoke production, high and low pressure zones, thermal feedback, rollover and flashover. The students are shown, and can practice under working fire conditions, nozzle techniques that can be used in any interior setting.
