The public hearing is being held to receive comments on the following proposed rules:

- **Wage and Hour Division General Rules** (ORR #2013-017LR) The proposed rules will amend R 408.701, R 408.706, and R 408.711, and R 408.712 and R 408.713 will be rescinded.
- **Payment of Wages and Fringe Benefits Rules** (ORR #2013-019LR ) The proposed rules will amend R 408.9002, R 408.9012, R 408.9019, R 408.9026, R 408.9027, R 408.9028, and R 408.9034, and R 408.9036 will be added to the Code.

These rules are being promulgated by the director of the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs by authority conferred on the director by section 6 of 1964 PA 154, MCL 408.386 and Executive Reorganization Order Nos. 1996-2, 1997-11, 2002-1, and 2003-1, MCL 445.2001, 421.94, 445.2004, and 445.2011 and by sections 9 and 12 of 1978 PA 390, MCL 408.479 and MCL 408.482, and Executive Reorganization Order Nos. 1996-2, 1997-11, 2002-1, and 2003-1, MCL 445.2001, 421.94, and 445.2004, and 445.2011. These rules are proposed to take effect seven days filing with the Secretary of State.

Comments on the proposed rules may be presented in person at the public hearing. Written comments may be submitted at the time of presentation and will also be accepted until 5:00 p.m. on May 21, 2014, at the following address or e-mail address:
