Enclosed, please find your next update to the Michigan Liquor Control Code, Administrative Rules and Related Laws. The pages included herein replace those already present in your book. For an updated electronic copy of this publication, you may also wish to visit the Commission's Documents Library section of our website at www.michigan.gov/lcc.

The following provides a review of the changes that have occurred since your last update:

- MICHIGAN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE RESCISSION - ADVERTISING RULES
 - Effective March 7, 2013: Rescission of administrative rule R 436.1335 (Rule 35 - Political Advertising).
 - The exceptions to the rule virtually negate its prohibitions and create inconsistent regulation.
- MICHIGAN LIQUOR CONTROL CODE AMENDMENT - GROWLERS
 - (SB-27) P.A. 101 of 2013, Effective July 2, 2013.
 - Amends MCL 436.1537 (Section 537)
 - This law amends the Michigan Liquor Control Code to expand the kinds of enterprises\merchants\licensees legally allowed to refill growlers with beer for consumption off the premises.
- MICHIGAN LIQUOR CONTROL CODE AMENDMENT - FARMER'S MARKET PERMITS
 - (SB-79) P.A. 100 of 2013, Effective August 31, 2013.
 - Adds MCL 436.1415 (Section 415)
 - This law amends the Michigan Liquor Control Code by adding a section to allow for the permitting of qualified small wine makers to conduct wine tastings and to sell the wine they produce at retail farmer's markets.
- MICHIGAN LIQUOR CONTROL CODE AMENDMENT – PENALTY FOR FOOD ASSISTANCE BENEFIT USE IN ALCOHOL PURCHASES
 - (HB-4360) P.A. 55 of 2013, Effective September 10, 2013.
 - Adds MCL 436.1903a (Section 903a)
 - This law amends the Michigan Liquor Control Code by adding a section that subjects liquor licensees to suspension or revocation of their license if the licensee engages in an electronic transaction involving the sale of alcohol using Food Assistance Program benefits.



- MICHIGAN PENAL CODE AMENDMENT – REDEMPTION GAMES
 - (HB-4932) P.A. 219 of 2010, Effective December 9, 2010.
 - Amends MCL 750.310b (Section 310a)
 - This law amends the Michigan Penal Code to double the maximum value of accumulated redemption coupon prizes under an exemption from the Code's gambling prohibitions.
 - This update to the Code occurred in 2010, but was erroneously not included in previous versions of the *Michigan Liquor Control Code, Administrative Rules and Related Laws*.
- UPDATED REFERENCE SECTIONS
 - This month's replacement pages also include a fully updated version of this publication's Table of Contents and Index.
