Enclosed, please find your next update of the Michigan Liquor Control Code, Administrative Rules and Related Laws. The pages included herein replace those already present in your book. The following provides a brief review of the changes that have occurred since your last update:

- MICHIGAN LIQUOR CONTROL CODE AMENDMENT – REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT LICENSES
 - (SB-846) P.A. 270 of 2014, Effective July 2, 2014.
 - Amends MCL 436.1521a (Section 521a)
 - This bill amended the Michigan Liquor Control Code to allow the Liquor Control Commission (LCC) to issue a public on-premises license, in addition to the allowed quota licenses, to a business located in a redevelopment project area or development district in a village or township, as well as one located in a city.
- MICHIGAN LIQUOR CONTROL CODE AMENDMENT - CONDITIONAL LIQUOR LICENSURE
 - (HB-4683) P.A. 194 of 2014, Effective June 24, 2014.
 - Amends MCL 436.2031 (Section 1031)
 - This bill amends the Michigan Liquor Control Code to eliminate a provision exempting wine auction licensees from having to comply with the registration requirements of registered auctioneers under Article 29 of the Occupational Code.
- MICHIGAN LIQUOR CONTROL CODE – PUBLICATION ERROR CORRECTION
 - MCL 436.1605
 - Corrected a typographical error located on pages 89-90 of the prior version of this publication.
