## **Executive Summary:**

Public Act 84 of 2015 requires the following:

**Section 902(1):** *Not later than November 30, the department shall prepare a report that provides the number of registry identification cards issued to or renewed for patients residing in each county as of September 30, of the preceding fiscal year, under the Michigan medical marihuana act, 2008 IL 1, MCL 333.26421 to 333.26430. The department shall submit this report to the state budget director; the subcommittees, and the fiscal agencies.*

Pursuant to this requirement, this report has been prepared and issued electronically to the House and Senate appropriations subcommittees, House and Senate Fiscal Agencies, and the state budget director to meet the November 30, 2015 reporting requirement.
