**OBJECTION TO RENEWAL OF LICENSE**  
**SHOW CAUSE HEARING ORDER**

Select Hotels Group, L.L.C. (A Delaware Limited Liability Company) d/b/a Hyatt Place (licensee) holds a 2014 Class C license with Sunday Sales Permit (A.M.) and Specific Purpose Permit (Food) at the above-noted location.

The City of Auburn Hills filed an objection to the 2015-2016 renewal of the Class C license under MCL 436.1501(2), through Resolution No. 15.03.051a adopted by the City Council at a regular meeting held on March 23, 2015.

Under MCL 436.1501(2), licenses issued by the Commission expire each year on April 30. Further, licenses for consumption of alcoholic liquor on the premises require approval by the local legislative body in which the applicant's place of business is located (except in a city with a population of 600,000 or more) before issuance of a license, and

also before renewal of an existing license if an objection to renewal has been filed with the Commission by the local legislative body not less than 30 days before expiration of the license on April 30.

The Commission properly noticed a Show Cause Hearing under administrative rule R 436.1925(1) to be held on April 24, 2015 in Lansing, to determine whether or not the subject license held by the licensee should be renewed for the 2015-2016 licensing year, cancelled, or revoked.

Prior to the scheduled hearing date, the City of Auburn Hills submitted correspondence dated April 23, 2015 withdrawing objection to renewal of the license.

The Commission finds that the population of Auburn Hills is less than 600,000. The Commission further finds that MCL 436.1501(2) requires the approval of the local legislative body, and the City of Auburn Hills has filed with the Commission a Resolution approving the renewal of the subject Class C license for the 2015 renewal year.

Article IV, Section 40, of the Michigan Constitution (1963), permits the legislature to establish a Liquor Control Commission, which shall exercise complete control of the alcoholic beverage traffic within this state, including the retail sales thereof, subject to statutory limitations. MCL 436.1201(2) provides the Commission with the sole right, power, and duty to control the alcoholic beverage traffic and traffic in other alcoholic liquor within this state, including the manufacture, importation, possession, transportation and sale thereof.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. The Class C license with Sunday Sales Permit (A.M.) and Specific Purpose Permit (Food) held by Select Hotels Group, L.L.C. (A Delaware Limited Liability Company) d/b/a Hyatt Place at the above-noted location is RENEWED for the 2015-2016 licensing year effective April 30, 2015 at 11:59 p.m. EST, subject to the following:


1. The licensee shall submit executed renewal form(s) and payment of the statutory license fees for the Class C license for the 2015-2016 licensing year by April 30, 2015.
2. Failure to submit the statutory license fees shall result in the license being terminated pursuant to the provisions of administrative rule R 436.1107, without further order of the Commission.
