1. Sam's Mart Inc., Treasury Account #F201583128, BID #157973

The Treasury Hearing was conducted for Sam's Mart Inc., Treasury Account #F201583128, Business ID #157973. Gerald Whalen appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Steve Schaub appeared on behalf of the Treasury Department. Attorney Whalen noted that the Warrant – Notice of Levy detailing this matter from the Treasury Department was a factual statement of the case. After discussion on the record, Commissioner Weatherspoon made a motion to allow the license to remain in escrow to allow the Treasury Department to pursue all necessary actions against the licensee to preserve the State's interest. Commissioner Quimby supported, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

2. Dewulf Enterprise Inc., Treasury Account #F383481228, BID #129201
