VA Medical Foster Home Program

The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs continues to develop the Medical Foster Home Program at the VA Ann Arbor Healthcare System and the Battle Creek VA Medical Center. A

Medical Foster Home (MFH) is an Adult Foster Care Family Home combined with a VA interdisciplinary Home Based Primary Care team to provide a safe, home-like environment and an economical long-term care alternative for Veterans who are unable to live independently. The MFH program helps match eligible Veterans with approved homes and experienced caregivers. VA first piloted the Medical Foster Home Program in 1999 and is now operating this program at 121 sites in 42 states/territories.

Medical Foster Homes in Michigan are required to have a State of Michigan license for an Adult Foster Care Home. The AFC Family Home license is preferred as the MFH program requires that the home be owned or rented by the caregiver and be the caregiver's primary place of residence. The Veteran will pay the caregiver directly and will receive room, board, personal care, and 24 hour supervision while living in a Medical Foster home. Caregivers will be screened and matched to Veterans who are enrolled in or qualify for the Home Based Primary Care program. Medical Foster Homes will be subject to inspections by VA and the Home Based Primary Care team will make routine visits to ensure Veterans are receiving quality care.

Medical Foster Home Highlights:

- Private or semi-private room
- 24 hours care and supervision
- Medication management
- Personal care (dressing, grooming, bathing, etc.)
- Meals, laundry, cleaning
- Flexible daily routine with personal/individualized care
- Variety of relationships and recreational options
- Maximum of 3 residents/care recipients (Veterans and/or Non-Veterans) per home
- Possibility of pets

VA is actively recruiting experienced caregivers for this program who are willing and able to care for 1-3 Veterans in their home.
