Employs or contracts not fewer than 2 full-time, licensed instructors.	§1110(1)(e)
The college is completely partitioned from any other place of business or dwelling.	§1110(1)(f)
One stationary wash basin with hot and cold running water and a connected drain for every two chairs. Sufficient practical training stations so students are not required to share during training periods.	§1110(1)(g)/ R 41(3)(a)
Licenses of the barber college, all instructors, student instructors, and students are displayed in a prominent place visible to the public at all times.	§1110(6)
All outside openings screened against insects during the season when insects are prevalent, except where air condition is in use.	R 31(2)
Floors, walls, ceilings, fixtures, and furnishings shall be kept clean.	R 31(2)
Waste containers shall be cleaned and disinfected at least once every 24 hours and shall be large enough to contain 1 day's accumulation of waste.	R 31(2)
Barbering equipment and supplies stored separately from storage for any other purpose. Soiled towels or rubbish are not allowed to accumulate on the premises or adjacent areas.	R 31(3)
All implements and instruments properly sterilized after each use, and maintained in a sanitary condition in a drawer or covered container.	R 33(1-5)
Clean, fresh paper or cloth towel used for each patron.	R 37(1)
Hair cloth or cape used on each patron with clean, fresh towel, or sanitary paper, or cloth neck strip placed around the neck to prevent the hair cloth or cape from touching the skin.	R 37(3)
All rooms have adequate ventilation and lighting.	R 41(1)(d)
A classroom, practical training room, separate student locker area and lavatory facilities with hot and cold running water and a connected drain.	R 41(1)(a-d)
Sufficient desk chairs for all students attending.	R 41(2)(a)
One chalkboard not less than 6' x 3 1/2' in size.	R 41(2)(b)
One chart of the skin and hair.	R 41(2)(c)
One standard dictionary and 1 illustrated medical dictionary.	R 41(2)(d)
Ample lamps and vibrators for demonstrations.	R 41(3)(c)
Ample supply of steamers, sources of lather and clean towels provided by college.	R 41(3)(d)
Each practical training station is not less than 6 feet from the next chair (measured from center to center of each base).	R 41(5)(a)
Each practical training station has one storage cabinet for tools, clean towels and hair cloths.	R 41(5)(b)
Each practical training station has one electric sterilizer.	R 41(5)(c)

Time records that correspond with the Board copy of the monthly report of student hours and a copy posted in a conspicuous location.	R 49(3)
