## **DECISION AND ORDER**

On October 27, 2009, Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) David M. Peltz issued his Decision and Recommended Order in the above matter pursuant to Sections 10 and 16 of the Public Employment Relations Act (PERA), 1965 PA 379, as amended, MCL 423.210 and 423.216. After requesting and receiving three extensions of time, Respondent filed its exceptions to the ALJ's Decision and Recommended Order, on January 27, 2010. Charging Party requested and received an extension of time to file its response to the exceptions and filed cross-exceptions on February 23, 2010. Respondent filed its response to Charging Party's cross-exceptions on March 5, 2010, and on March 26, 2010, filed a motion to dismiss.

On May 13, 2010, the Commission received a letter from Respondent indicating that the dispute underlying the charge had been settled, requesting leave to withdraw its exceptions, and asking that the ALJ's Decision and Recommended Order not be published. Following further communications between the parties and the Commission's staff, the Commission received a letter from Charging Party on August 16, 2010, confirming that the parties have reached agreement, indicating that Charging Party joins Respondent's request that the ALJ's Decision and Recommended Order not be published, and requesting that the charge

be withdrawn. The parties' requests are hereby approved. The Decision and Recommended Order of the Administrative Law Judge will not be published.
