Dear Commissioners,

The City of Caseville would like to reduce the area that was requested for annexation. The southernmost parcel that was added, by the City, after the initial request, should be dropped from consideration for annexation.

This change has resulted from discussions with the owner of Blue Chip Machining Co. who has told us that the company would not oppose annexation of the original parcels that have always been in the Village/City if the additional parcel was not requested to be included. The company's opposition to the original proposed annexation parcels came about when the City added the southern Township parcel.

The parcel that is requested to be dropped from the annexation proposal is the one (in the blue binder supplied to the Boundary Commissioners at the Public hearing in Caseville) that is labeled **ADDITIONAL ANNEXATION REQUEST SOUTHERN PARCEL (TOWNSHIP)** and can be identified with the orange marking.

A letter from Blue Chip Machining that details the agreement to not oppose the original annexation will be provided also. The company's support for the original annexation along with James Devroye's, the only other property owner in the proposed annexation area, provides total approval of the annexation by the owner's of the parcels in the proposed annexation area.
