Petition for Annexation of territory in Caseville Township to the City of
Caseville (Huron County)

The following comments are for your consideration on the legal sufficiency of this petition:

1. This petition to request the annexation of territory in Caseville Township to the City of Caseville, by council resolution, was filed with the Boundary Commission on January 20, 2011. The petition contains a copy of Caseville City Council Resolution #74-2010 to prepare and submit an annexation petition with the State Boundary Commission as required by Rule 25(4).
2. The petition contains an 8 1/2"x 14" PART I map. The PART III legal description closes mathematically and is substantially accurate and consistent with the PART I Map. The territory proposed for annexation in the Part III description is contiguous with the City of Caseville limits, based upon the documentation provided by the Secretary of State as of February 9, 2011.
3. Based upon our review, it is our position that legal sufficiency has been met for this petition.
