The Michigan Administrative Hearing System has removed this case from its docket, and closed its file in this matter.


The Settlement Agreement is attached hereto, incorporated by reference into this Order, and transmitted to the Director of the Department of Human Services.





On August 19, 2014, the Bureau of Children and Adult Licensing issued a *Notice of Intent to Revoke* the adult foster care small group home license of Comfort Zone Home Care Services, LLC. In settlement of all issues raised in the *Notice of Intent to Revoke*, the undersigned parties hereby agree:

- 1) Comfort Zone Home Care Services, LLC neither admits nor denies that the specific allegations set forth in the *Notice of Intent* are true.
- 2) Comfort Zone Home Care Services, LLC agrees to the administrative closure of its adult foster care small group home license.
- 3) Comfort Zone Home Care Services, LLC understands that the administrative closure of its adult foster care small group home license will be effective May 28, 2015.
- 4) Comfort Zone Home Care Services, LLC understands that this settlement agreement is not effective until the issuance of the *Order Approving Settlement Agreement*.
- 5) Comfort Zone Home Care Services, LLC understands that it is waiving its right to contest the allegations set forth in the *Notice of Intent to Revoke*, and the administrative hearing in this matter, Docket No. 14-029074-DHS, scheduled for January 26, 2015, will be canceled.
- 6) Comfort Zone Home Care Services, LLC understands that due to the November 25, 2014, revocation of Strathmoor Manor, license number AS820284341, and pursuant to MCL 400713(10)(11), Bartholomew Ajulufoh cannot apply for a license for an adult foster care facility licensed under the Adult Foster Care Facility Licensing Act or have a relationship with a license until November 24, 2019.




