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APPROVAL OF MINUTES

MOTION by Kevan Kreitman, seconded by Dr. Mohammed Arsiwala to accept the minutes of the January 14, 2014 meeting with the date of the approval of previous meeting being changed to reflect April 16, 2013.

MOTION PREVAILED

Presentation by Dr. Catherine Reid – Naloxone (handout)

- Naloxone is used in opioid overdose
- Approved by the FDA in 1971
- Comes in 3 Forms
- 23 States have Good Samaritan Law
- Michigan is contemplating such law – Senate Bill 0860 and House Bill 5407

PMP Interconnect Update

- Tim Smith indicated that there were 25 States connected to the hub
- Dr. Arsiwala asked about MAPS, no information was available.
- Dr. Arsiwala asked that education for MAPS be made available
- How many MAPS users vs. how many licenses?
- Daily reporting went in to affect July 1, 2014

SB 704 (Compounding Bill)

- Tim Smith indicated that the bill was passed and signed by Governor

Electronic Prescribing of Controlled Substances

- Tim Smith indicated that there has to be a DEA compatible system with the prescriber and the pharmacy for E-scribe prescriptions
- Dr. Arsiwala indicated that there is a conflict with prescribing
- Computer to computer – allowed for CII-V and non-controlled
- Computer to fax – not allowed due to authentication system
- Mr. Westra asked Tim Smith to check in to authentication systems for next meeting.
- Delegating Physicians were discussed. Physician Assistants can prescribe schedule CII-V with a supervising physician's DEA and the PA's DEA. Nurse

Practitioners can prescribe CIII –V with a supervising physician's DEA and the NP's DEA.

Public Comment

- Dr. Reid stated there is a 50% statewide MAPS registry
- Susan Affholter stated that the CDC report indicates if a provider gets a bad report, they still do not change behavior. 70% of drug overdose is by taking someone else's medication.
- Don Gentner from BCBSM indicated that they have a \$300 cap on compounding prescriptions.
- Stephen Gobbo introduced himself as the bureau's deputy director


MOTION by Dr. Arsiwala, seconded by Nichole Penny to adjourn meeting.

The next CSAC meeting is to be held October 14, 2014




